



LUALUALEI HAWAIIAN CIVIC CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

The Lualualei Hawaiian Civic Club (LHCC) was founded in 2008 and officially became chartered under the Association of Hawaiian Civic Club at the 2008 Convention. We have been an active club in the Wai‘anae Moku since.

Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalaniana‘ole was a prince of the Kingdom of Hawai‘i until it was overthrown. He went on to becoming the Delegate of the Territory to the Congress of the United States. Prince Kūhiō was a key figure in the founding of the very first Hawaiian Civic Club in 1918. He wanted Hawaiians to be outstanding citizens and leaders in their communities so that they could and would take an active part in the civic progress of Hawai‘i. The Lualualei Hawaiian Civic Club is dedicated to the vision of our ali‘i and are committed to the perpetuation of our people and culture through aloha.

Eligibility

- 1) Must reside in the 96792 zip code (Nānākuli-Mākaha).
- 2) Must be graduating from a local High School in current academic year.
- 3) Be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited 2 or 4 year college/university or trade/occupational school
- 4) Must have a current cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0.
- 5) Community Service. You must have "unpaid" community service to an organization, individual (Pastor, Congressperson, Teacher, etc.), or your school. This must be documented by our Community Service form being filled out by the organization, individual, or school representative.
- 6) If awarded, you must complete 12 Community Service Hours for Lualualei Hawaiian Civic Club
- 7) If awarded, you or a family member must become an active member of the LHCC for the next year.

Required Application & Supporting Documents

Please submit the following items so your application can proceed to the review committee

- 1. LHCC Scholarship Application** completed online via our website or the attached form.
- 2. Official Transcript** (issued within six months of this application) must be emailed/mailed directly from the Academic institution to LHCC no later than April 1st.
- 3. A Letter of Acceptance** from the institution you will be attending.
- 4. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation** from teachers, advisors, counselors, mentors, and/or employers. Letters from friends and relatives are not accepted. Letters must be emailed/mailed directly from recommenders to LHCC no later than April 1st.
- 5. LHCC Community Service Form(s)** completed & signed. State the types of unpaid, volunteer service you are currently doing for others OR have completed within the last 12 months. This can include service to an organization, individual (Pastor, Congressperson, Teacher, etc.), school, or church. The Club has a strong stance on community service and encourages students to participate in activities that give back to our Lualualei communities.
- 6. Personal Statement** addressing the following:
 - A. Your reason(s) for attending college/university/trade school
 - B. What is your course study and reason(s) for choosing it
 - C. Your career goal(s)
 - D. Your commitment to the preservation, cultivation, and perpetuation of the native Hawaiian culture and how you hope to continue that in your career?
 - E. Any financial hardship, obstacles, or special circumstances to be considered.
 - F. Your involvement in community service and/or service to others and the personal impact it has had on you.

Personal statements should be typed, double spaced, and no more than 4 pages. We kindly ask that you have your statement checked for spelling and grammar errors. Title your document "Personal Statement" followed by your first and last name.
